

Technical data sheet - Recital T





Description

A stand-out multipurpose upholstered chair. Suitable for use on telescopic platforms or as a fixed auditorium chair, it features an individual fold-away writing tablet. The retractable version is cleverly designed with seat, back, arms and end panels which fold into a small envelope to allow platforms to be retracted.

Features

- Designed for comfort with good lumbar support
- Enclosed, damped, spring-tip mechanism for safety and smooth, silent action
- Ideal for stand alone applications, or for use on TX platform systems - TX version is suitable for min. 11³/₄" row rise
- Decorative timber panel to rear (optional for seat pan)
- Optional writing tablet

Dimensions

- Seat width (centre to centre): 195/8", 201/2", 211/4"
- Minimum row rise on telescopic platforms without facias: 11¾"
- Minimum row depth on telescopic platforms: 35%"
 Greater row depths (37%"- 39%" depending on exact configuration) may be required if fascias are specified.

Standard Specification

- Seat: Timber core, with moulded polyurethane foam, fully upholstered.
- Back: Timber core, with molded polyurethane foam, incorporating a plywood outer protection panel.
- Tipping Mechanism: Damped, self rising spring tip mechanism.
- Armrests: Solid timber with clear lacquer.
- Writing tablet: Double sided melamine faced MDF in wood effect or plain colored finish. Edges finished with matching PVC banding. Powder coated steel bracket.

- End Panels: Steel plate with beech veneered timber show panel.
- Steelwork Finish: Epoxy polyester powder coated finish, colour RAL 9005 black.
- Fold Down Mechanism (when used with TX platforms):
 Manually operated RUM mechanism.
